



START-UP and MAINTENANCE

for all other Pool Breeze® pools

Start-Up:

1. Take a water sample to your *Authorized Pool Breeze Dealer* for a complete analysis.
2. Add Pool Breeze® Shock Treatment and Superchlorinator, Pool Breeze® Shock 35, or Pool Breeze® Non-chlorine Shock Treatment.
3. Begin treatment with Pool Breeze® Granules, Tablets, or Sticks to maintain a free available chlorine level between 1-3 ppm.
4. Add an initial dose of Pool Breeze® Algicide, Pool Breeze® Algicide 60, or Pool Breeze® Copper Algicide.
5. Clean winter cover, and store in a cool, dry area.
6. Resume normal weekly/monthly routine. Remember to clean filter twice a season.

NOTE: If using 3" Tablets, 1" Tablets or Sticks, Pool Breeze Shock Treatment and Superchlorinator should be used to bring the chlorine level to 1-3 ppm.

Maintenance:

Daily

1. Run filter per manufacturer's directions a minimum of 8-12 continuous hours per day to remove unwanted suspended debris (24 hours per day during periods of heavy usage). Backwash the filter according to manufacturer's recommendations.
2. Clean debris from the skimmer, hair and lint strainer basket, and the pool as necessary. This debris can reduce the filter's ability to trap debris and will greatly affect the pump's ability to circulate the water.
3. Test pH, chlorine and total alkalinity levels using Pool Breeze® Test Strips. Adjust pH to 7.2-7.8 to maintain a free available chlorine level between 1-3 ppm to ensure water is properly sanitized.

Weekly

1. Check the filter backpressure to ensure that it remains within the manufacturer's recommended range. Only backwash according to manufacturer's directions.
2. Shock the pool with Pool Breeze® Shock Treatment and Superchlorinator, Pool Breeze® Shock 35, or Pool Breeze® Non-chlorine Shock Treatment per label directions.
3. Add a maintenance dose of Pool Breeze® Algicide, Pool® Breeze Algicide 60, or Pool Breeze® Copper Algicide per label directions.
4. Brush pool sides and bottom.
