



START-UP and MAINTENANCE

for pools treated with the Pool Breeze® Advantage System



Start-Up:

1. After the filter has run for 3-4 hours, take a water sample to your *Authorized Dealer*. Adjust water balance if necessary. If metals are detected, add Pool Breeze® Metal Removing Agent per label directions.
2. Shock the pool with Pool Breeze® Advantage Shock & Clarifier.
3. Begin treating pool with Pool Breeze® Advantage Sanitizer to maintain a free chlorine level of 1-3 ppm.
4. Add an initial dose of Pool Breeze® Advantage Algicide per label directions.

Maintenance:

1. Add Pool Breeze® Advantage Sanitizer per label directions once a week to kill bacteria and break up organic matter.
NOTE: Because Pool Breeze® Advantage Shock & Clarifier is a non-chlorine based shock, swimmers may re-enter the pool 15 minutes after the treatment.
2. Add Pool Breeze® Shock & Clarifier once a week per label directions to break up organic matter that can cause water to become cloudy or dull.
3. Add Pool Breeze® Advantage Algicide once a week per label directions to prevent algae growth.

Monthly Pool Care:

A water sample should be brought to your *Authorized Pool Breeze Dealer* monthly for full analysis. Any water balance factors that are out of range should be adjusted.

NOTE: Clean your filter at least twice a season.
